Dear Potential Graduate:

The Commencement Ceremony for the 2018-2019 school year will take place at the Innisfil Recreation Complex on Thursday, June 27, 2019 at 2:30 p.m. Ceremony doors will open at 2:00 p.m. We cordially invite members of your family to attend the ceremony.

There is a cost of **\$40.00 (non-refundable)** for graduates to participate in the ceremony. This fee covers your gown, cap, tassel and sash purchase as well as general commencement expenses. **Please log-in to your School Cash On-Line account to pay for your gown and cap before May 31st.** Print your order receipt and bring it to the guidance office to receive your 3 complimentary tickets. Please ensure these are kept in a safe place as **additional tickets will be available after May 31st, but at a cost of \$5/ticket.** Additional tickets may be purchased at the guidance office (**cash only**).

A **Graduate Card** is a card stating your intentions for life after graduation that is read while you are on stage receiving your diploma. Graduates will be required to complete a card **at the ceremony**, so please be prepared.

A professional photographer from Edge Imaging will be photographing every graduate as they receive their diploma on stage. **Pictures will be available to purchase on-line at www.edgephotos.ca after the ceremony.**

Graduates are to be at the Recreation Complex by **2:00 p.m.**, dressed in their gowns, to be put into proper ceremony order. ***All groups must be ready to enter the ceremony by 2:30 p.m. sharp.***

As well, **there will be a selection of flowers for purchase after** the ceremony. Prices range between \$15 and \$25.

Please note that **ALL** graduation requirements **MUST** be completed in order to attend the ceremony. **Community Service Hours must be submitted by May 1st.** All course work must be submitted no later than the final exam date for each respective course. Failure to meet these deadlines may result in either not being able to attend the ceremony and/or the graduate's name not being printed in the commencement program.
